Hebrews 9:11-14

Hebrews 9:11 But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, a with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.

9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

9:13 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, Heb 9:14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 8:6

Hebrews 8:6 But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises.

Exodus 15:26

Exodus 15:26 and said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the LORD who heals you."

Hebrews 7:22

Hebrews 7:22 by so much more Jesus has become a surety of a better covenant.

Romans 4:19

Romans 4:19 And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb.

Hebrews 6:10-19

Hebrews 6:10 For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of a love which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

6:11 And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end,

6:12 that you do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

6:13 For when God made a promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself,

6:14 saying, "Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you."

6:15 And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

6:16 For men indeed swear by the greater, and an oath for confirmation is for them an end of all dispute.

6:17 Thus God, determining to show more abundantly to the heirs of promise the immutability of His counsel, confirmed it by an oath,

6:18 that by two immutable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before us.

6:19 This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil,

Hebrews 11:11

Hebrews 11:11 By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child a when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised.

Isaiah 53:1-5

Isaiah 53:1 Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

53:2 For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him.

53:3 He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

53:4 Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.

53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.
